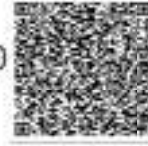

1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* praying for quashing impugned orders/notices dated 17.05.2024 (Annexure P-7) and 14.06.2024 (Annexure P-8).
