1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.158 dated 25.06.2024 under Sections 376(2)(n), 506 IPC and Section 67-A of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008 registered at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani.
2. The petitioner was directed to join the investigation, as per the order dated 28.10.2024 passed by this Court.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on



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instructions from ASI Karamvir Singh confirms that the petitioner has joined the investigation and also contends that his further custodial interrogation is not required. He has informed that even supplementary statement of respondent No.2 has been recorded, wherein she has stated that compromise has been effected between the parties.

4. The allegations against the petitioner are matter of trial.

5. In view of the reasons recorded in the order dated 28.10.2024 and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, his further custodial interrogation is not required by the Investigating Agency, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.10.2024, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. However, it is made clear that nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.

7. Liberty is reserved in favour of the State/complainant to move for cancellation/recall of the order in case the petitioner violates any condition stipulated under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C., or upon showing any other sufficient cause.

8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
