Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) seeking quashing of FIR No.160 dated 18.04.2020 under Sections 188/269 of IPC, 1860 read with Section 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act registered at Police Station Jhabal, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
