AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

Petitioner – Bhupinder Singh Bawa has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking necessary permission to go abroad i.e. United Kingdom (BIVS) and Canada from 20th July to 2nd November, 2024.

2. It is pointed out that petitioner has already filed one CRM-M No. 9747 of 2024 for quashing of order dated 23.02.2024 in which notice has been issued and further proceedings in the said FIR till next date of hearing were stayed, which is Annexure P-1. Petitioner is to attend birthday ceremony of his grandson and granddaughters in United Kingdom and Canada, as referred in para No. 2 of petition. Application filed by petitioner seeking permission to go abroad was declined by trial Court since the proceedings were stayed by Hon'ble High Court. Copy of application dated

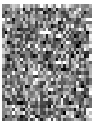
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23.05.2024 is Annexure P-2 and copy of order dated 15.06.2024 is Annexure P-3. Present petitioner is ready to furnish any type of surety, bank guarantee etc. to ensure his return. Photocopy of his Passport and Visa are Annexures P-4 and P-5. Hence, the present petition.

3. Learned counsel representing the State has filed status report confirming the factual position as referred above. However, application is opposed by alleging that petitioner intentionally and willfully wants to go abroad to avoid consequences of FIR No. 236 dated 06.11.2008, under Sections 279, 304-A, 427 of IPC, registered at Police Station Samrala. He may not return to India at all. Therefore, application may be dismissed.

4. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record. In this petition, petitioner has sought permission to go abroad i.e. United Kingdom and Canada from 20.07.2024 to 02.11.2024. He is ready to furnish surety bonds/bank guarantee as per orders of Court. It is matter of record that petitioner has filed another CRM-M No. 9747 of 2024 in which proceedings in aforesaid FIR have been stayed. Said case is also fixed for today. Therefore, proceedings in the said FIR are not going to be adversely effected. Petitioner is ready to furnish surety bonds, bank guarantee as per the direction of this Court.

Considering the aforesaid factual position, petition filed by petitioner – Bhupinder Singh Bawa is allowed. He is permitted to go abroad i.e. United Kingdom and Canada from 01.08.2024 till 02.11.2024 on furnishing adequate personal as well as surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate concerned and he will also furnish bank guarantee/FDR worth ₹10 lacs before the said Court, which he will be



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entitled to receive back on his return on 02.11.2024.

- 5. Petition is accordingly, disposed of.
- 6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
