1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the ad-hoc service period of the petitioner i.e. 29.01.1986 to 01.04.1993 followed with regular appointment from 01.04.1993 for the purpose of pensionary benefits i.e. pension/gratuity as the respondent-Corporation has not paid the calculated amount of ad-hoc service and paid the said amount of superannuation to the petitioner i.e. on 30.10.2023 as Godown-Attendant-cum-Watchman (GACW) related with the period of ad-hoc service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had submitted a representation dated 30.01.2024 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.1 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid



representation dated 30.01.2024 (Annexure P-7) is considered and decided by respondent No.1 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of both the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated 30.01.2024 (Annexure P-7) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
