1. On 17.07.2024, this Court passed the following order:

“Petitioner-Satpal Kaur, who is widow of Late Bogha Singh has filed the present writ petition for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to grant her the ex-gratia amount under the approved Ex- Gratia Scheme/Welfare Schemes under Rule 265 of the Punjab Rules, 2008, which were framed under the Building and other Construction Workers Welfare (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Services) Act, 1996.
