This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the lie and liberty of the petitioners and protection from false implication in a criminal case on the instigation of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is given to the competent authority to look into the matter and their representations dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P2) and 09.07.2024 (Annexure P7) is decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. Counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of the complete paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

5. Heard.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to decide the representations dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P2) and 09.07.2024 (Annexure P7) within a period of 02 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law and to provide necessary protection to the petitioners in case situation so warrants.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
