Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned order dated 21.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) has been passed by the respondents terminating the services of the petitioner without following the process envisaged under the Rules qua the members, who have been appointed under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents, on the instructions from Mr. Amarjit Singh Bhullar Deputy Director, Department of Social Security,

dated 21.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order in accordance with law by giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and appropriate fresh order on the issue will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the impugned order dated 21.06.2024 (Annexure P-3) has been withdrawn hence, the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
