1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for violating order dated 09.04.2024 passed by this Court in CWP 26052-2017.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana and Mr. Harkesh Kumar accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. While referring to order dated 10.07.2024, passed by the respondent, he has submitted that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has been complied with and copy thereof has also been produced in the Court. The Registry is directed to tag the aforesaid order with the file after scanning at an appropriate place.
4. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
