AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

“Sh. Alankar Narula, Advocate, counsel for the appellants states that if an amount of Rs.1,10,000/- is paid to the appellant over and above the amount already awarded by the learned MACT, then he is ready for settlement.

On getting instructions from his client, he signed the settlement sheet. However, in this case, liability is a joint liability of two companies i.e. respondents No.5 and 6, both of whom are required to make payment in equal shares. The counsel for respondent No.5-New India Insurance Company is not available today, so that his consent could be taken.

Adjourned to 30.05.2024.”

The appeal has been settled. Statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsels for the Insurance Companies, have been separately recorded. An amount of Rs.1,10,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Ten Thousand Only) has been decided to be paid to the appellant which will be paid by both the companies, in equal shares i.e. Rs.55,000/- each.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to both the

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Insurance Companies to deposit cheques for Rs.55,000/- (Rupees Fifty Five Thousand Only) each, favouring appellant-Yaman Arora s/o Ashok Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 29.07.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be consigned to the record room.

Pending applications, if any shall stand disposed of.
