1. Having 'No Objection' from the earlier counsel, Mr. Gian Chand Shahpuri, Advocate, has appeared and filed his power of attorney on behalf of the petitioner. The same is taken on record.
2. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.06.2023 passed in CWP-12875-2023.
3. Learned State counsel and learned counsel for respondent No.3 have submitted that after considering the reply filed by the petitioner, the competent authority has passed the order. Even the said order had been challenged by the petitioner in statutory appeal. However, the said statutory appeal has also been dismissed.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.

5. Dismissed.
6. However, dismissal of the present petition would not be taken as an expression of merits of the case qua any other remedy available to the petitioner.
