By way of present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC,
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 26.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from SI



Jaswinder Singh has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

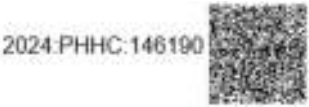
5. During the course of hearing on 26.09.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. In fact, the allegations levelled by the complainant in the FIR are mainly against accused Aman Kumar @ Aman Singh with whom the complainant has already effected compromise as is evident from the order dated 12.07.2024 passed in CRM-M-32569-2024. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

3. List on 25.10.2024.

4 . In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate with the same. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 26.09.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 26.09.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will



influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
