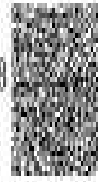

1. The petitioner – Priya has filed petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.49, dated 28.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC of 1860 registered at Police Station City Zira, District Ferozepur.
2. The brief facts of the case are that application was filed against Daljit Singh, Priya, Chhinder Singh and Bohar Singh for cheating the applicant-Bakshish Singh to the tune of Rs. 20 lacs on account of getting employment in Railway Department. After initial investigation, present FIR was registered.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that matter has been compromised before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre as per



settlement/agreement arrived at between the parties on 14.08.2024. The present petitioner will abide the terms of said compromise. She is also ready to join the investigation as and when required by the police.

4. Learned counsel representing complainant has also confirmed the compromise arrived at before Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

5. Learned counsel representing State pointed out that matter is under investigation. Therefore, the petitioner is required to join the investigation.

6. I have considered the arguments. As referred above, matter has been compromised before Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation. Anticipatory bail application is not opposed by the complainant.

7. Considering the facts of the case and without going on the merits, anticipatory bail filed by petitioner-Priya is allowed. In case she is arrested by the Investigating Officer then she be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join the investigation as and when required. She will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
