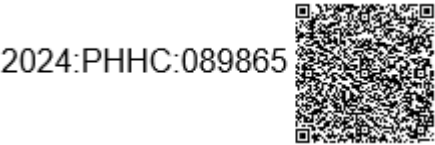
The present writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent-Department to release the electricity connection in the industrial plot of the petitioner as no amount/arrears is due from the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 6.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 to 6/DHBVNL submits that the petitioner has an alternative efficacious remedy to appear before the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum (CGRF) established by the Distribution Licensee under Section 42 (5) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and espouse his grievance before the same.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative/appropriate remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.



Disposed of as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.

Needless to mention, in the event of petitioner approaching the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum (CGRF) for redressal of his grievance, the same shall be decided within a period of 03 months thereafter.
