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 Learned counsel for the appellant stated that the SLPs filed by the Insurance Company before the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the matter have been dismissed. He has also placed on record the print out of Diary No. 17361 of 2010, which shows that one of the SLP referred to in order dated 19.11.2024 i.e. SLP No. 19808 of 2010 has been dismissed vide order dated 30.10.2013. Presumably, the other SLPs were also connected with the aforesaid SLP.

 As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.1,75,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant- Rakesh Kumar S/o Sh. Bichha Ram, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

 Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of Rs.1, 75,000/- favoring the appellant- Rakesh Kumar S/o Sh. Bichha Ram, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant’s counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the

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cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stand disposed of.
