KIRTI SINGH, J.(Oral)

This petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner in view of police report and investigation dated 10.06.2024 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No. 5 and to provide security/gunman to the petitioner as he has received threat calls from terrorists from international numbers.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed representation (Annexure P-6) dated 01.06.2024 to the Election Commissioner, Gurdaspur raising his grievance as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur to decide the

forementioned representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action



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thereon.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. R.S. Thind, DAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 4 to decide the aforementioned representation dated 01.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect his life and liberty.
