1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of interim bail under Section 439 read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for a period of two weeks for attending the bhog ceremony as well as last funeral rites of his brother, who expired on 09.07.2024, in case FIR No.329 dated 27.04.2023 under Sections 147, 149, 307, 323, 506 and 120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the brother of the petitioner expired on 09.07.2024 and his bhog ceremony is due to be performed on 21.07.2024 at Hisar. A prayer has, therefore, been made for extending the concession of interim bail to the petitioner for attending the bhog ceremony of his brother.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.



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5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shamsher, has not disputed that the brother of the petitioner has indeed expired on 09.07.2024, however, it has been brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner is a man of criminal antecedents as he is involved in 05 other criminal cases which fact has been withheld in the instant petition.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed on record.

7. In view of the above, the petitioner is allowed to attend the bhog ceremony of his brother on 21.07.2024 in police custody. The petitioner shall be taken under police cusotdy to the venue of the bhog ceremony i.e. at their residence at Hisar on 21.07.2024 at 07:00 A.M. and would be escorted back to the jail where he is presently lodged on the same day by 04:00 P.M. All travel expenses incurred by the authorities concerned, shall be borne by the petitioner.

8. The instant petition stands disposed of in above terms.
