The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.126 dated 29.06.2024 under Sections 420, 465, 468 of IPC and under Section 66 (c) of I.T Act, registered at Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 25.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Insp. Maninder Singh also submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
