For the reasons stated in the application, duly supported by an affidavit, delay of 13 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

Application is, accordingly, disposed of.

LPA-1764-2024 (O&M)

The appellants have filed this appeal assailing an interim order passed by the learned Single Judge on 31.05.2024 in CWP-14195-2024, whereby interim relief in terms of CWP-10992-2023, i.e. to maintain *status quo*, as existed on 01.01.2023, and restraining the respondents therein from adopting coercive means to recover the different amounts, has been granted.



2. Learned counsel for the appellants does not dispute that the appellants have not filed any application before the learned Single Judge to vacate the said impugned interim order.
3. It would be appropriate that prayer for vacating interim order is made in the first instance before the learned Single Judge.
4. At this juncture, learned counsel for the appellants prays for withdrawal of this appeal with liberty to move an application before the learned Single Judge for vacating the impugned interim order.
5. With the aforesaid liberty, without commenting on merits of the case, appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn.
6. All the pending applications stand disposed of.
