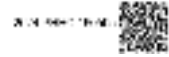

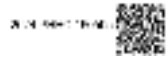

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the respondent-State by way of filing appropriate representation so as to prove the eligibility of the petitioner and prays that the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation and in case it is found feasible, the relief will be granted to the petitioner otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which order will be conveyed to



the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
