1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is claiming appointment to the post of driver whereas, he has been declared failed in the dug test by raising certain objections however, as per the video recording of the said dug test, the petitioner has cleared the said dug test.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per the video recording of the Dug test, the petitioner failed as, while reversing the vehicle, the petitioner had rubbed the side rear tyre against corner of the dug hence, the petitioner has rightly been declared failed. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case the petitioner is disputing the said fact, then the petitioner is raising the disputed question of fact, which cannot be gone into by this Court.
3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy

before the Civil Court so as to prove his claim on the basis of the video recording of the Dug test.

4. Ordered accordingly.
