By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of an appropriate writ for directing respondent Nos. 2 to 6 to take action on the representation dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-5), filed by the petitioner for providing the correct voter list of year 2023 pertaining to village Pandori Rajputta, Tehsil Bhulath, District Kapurthala, before Panchayat Election, as some of the votes have been shifted from one ward to another.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite making several requests, till date, no action has been taken on the aforesaid representation dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-5) made by the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the said representation shall be considered and decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law.

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4. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the record.
5. Considering the nature of relief being sought in the present writ petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation dated 11.07.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing a final order, in accordance with law, within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt or production of certified copy of this order.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
