1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 09.03.2023 passed in CWP-4631-2023.
2. Affidavit of Dr. Anshaj Singh, Director of Secondary Education, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 09.03.2023 passed in CWP-4631-2023 has been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has since been decided by passing a speaking order dated 26.07.2023/01.08.2023 (Annexure R-1).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
