2. The following order was passed on 22.07.2024 :-

Notice of motion for 23.08.2024.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1-State.

In the meantime, Parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaga Magistrate within a period of two weeks



or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of the compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 23.08.2024. This shall be the responsibility of the petitioners to secure the presence of respondent No. 2 before the jurisdictional Magistrate.

A copy of this order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. Thereafter, on 23.08.2024, the parties were again directed to appear before the jurisdictional/Illaq Magistrate within a period of two weeks. In compliance of the aforesaid order and order dated 23.09.2024, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834* and *Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63* and Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052*, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 17 dated 18.03.2021, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women, Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1/T) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners.
