Prayer in the present writ petition was to direct the respondents to provide adequate security cover to the petitioner.

There is a written request for an adjournment circulated on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that a short reply by way of affidavit of Ravinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tapa, District Barnala, dated 07.11.2022, on behalf of the respondents was filed wherein it is averred that the security cover has already been assessed and no security threat qua the petitioner has been found.

It is also noticed from the order sheets that counsel for the petitioner is not putting in appearance for the last three dates of hearing. The position remains the same today as well. It is apparent that adjournment slip has been circulated to unnecessarily delay the present petition and is misconceived. The same is accordingly declined.
