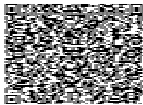

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the tax due as mentioned in order Annexure P/1 by the Assessment Officer was Rs.26,59,782/-, which stood already deposited and the documents have been placed on record to the said effect.
2. Learned counsel submits that the assessment order was challenged by moving rectification application but the same is still pending for adjudication.
3. Taking into consideration the above situation, learned counsel for the respondents does not have objection, if a direction is issued to the authorities to decide the rectification application in a time bound manner.



- 4. In view of the above, we accordingly direct the authorities to decide the rectification application within a period of one month from today.
