The prayer in the present petition(s) bearing CWP-18620-2020 and CWP-2872-2021 filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for quashing the order dated 16.09.2020 (Annexure P-10), wherein it has been stated that since the Departmental Action Committee is contemplated/pending against him due to which his notice for seeking voluntary retirement cannot be considered and for quashing the charge-sheet dated 09.12.2020 (Annexure P-11) for imposing minor punishment, respectively.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Shivek, Law Officer of Punjab Gramin Bank, submits that the petitioner shall be awarded minor punishment and thereafter, his request for voluntary retirement shall be accepted.

In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, let the said exercise for imposing minor punishment be completed and final order be passed by the respondent-Bank within a period of three weeks from today and thereafter, final order on the application of the petitioner, seeking voluntary retirement, be issued within a period of two weeks thereafter and the consequential pensionary benefits of the petitioner shall also be released, within a period of two months, thereafter.
