MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.156 dated 23.07.2022 registered under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana.

2. Vide order dated 20.12.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.12.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
