1. The present petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed, seeking issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction, including a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the impugned chargesheet dated 06.10.2017 (Annexure P-1), enquiry report dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P-2), impugned orders dated 31.12.2018 (Annexures P-3 & P-4), impugned orders dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-5) and impugned orders dated 30.08.2019 (Annexures P-6 and P-7).

2. The case has been called twice. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.
