1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.147, dated 26.07.2017, under Sections 307, 450, 323, 148, 149 of IPC (Section 511 IPC added lateron) and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

2. Vide order dated 28.08.2024, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 28.08.2024, petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 28.08.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

7. Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
