1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.05.2023 passed in CWP-11086-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Sangeeta B. Singh, Director, Saheed Haan Khan Mewati, Govt. Medical College, Nalhar, Nuh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 22.05.2023 passed in CWP-11086-2023 has been complied with. The necessary order has been passed and the benefit of 7th Pay Commission has also been granted to the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
