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AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner has filed present petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty as he is apprehending threats at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6. It is further alleged that respondents No.1 to 4 have not taken any account of his representation dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure P-4).
2. Notice of motion.
3. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State. He stated that representation of petitioner will be disposed of within two weeks.
4. Admittedly, present petitioner is residing in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, therefore no effective order can be passed to protect his life and liberty, since he is residing abroad. However, respondents No.2 to 4 are directed to look into the representation of petitioner dated 22.04.2024 and take appropriate steps as per law within two weeks.
5. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
