



petitioners. The complainant has further mentioned in the affidavit (Annexure P-2) that her mother used to remain in mental stress and had a lot of affection towards her. Due to uncertain reasons, she expired while crossing the railway track.

5. *Learned counsel for the complainant has confirmed the factum of execution of the affidavit of the complainant (Annexure P-2).*

6. *Adjourned to 24.10.2024.*

7. *In the meanwhile, the petitioners No.1 and 4 are directed to join investigation within a period of ten days and in the event of arrest, they shall be released on interim bail, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Area Magistrate, subject to furnishing bonds/surety, and also subject to the following conditions:-*

(i) That the petitioners shall further make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.

(ii) That the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.

(iii) That the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Trial Court/CJM concerned.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Birbal, submits that in compliance of order dated 02.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

4. Keeping in view the statement made by learned State Counsel, the order dated 02.09.2024, is made absolute. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C./ (482(2)BNSS).

5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed to be an

expression of opinion by this Court lest it may prejudice the trial. The learned trial Court is directed to proceed with the trial on its own merits, strictly in accordance with law.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
