AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Paramjit Kaur has filed this petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 directing respondents to submit status report in FIR No.297 dated 18.06.2024, under Sections 447, 511, 341, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala (Annexure P-1), as the accused named in FIR are roaming freely and threatening petitioner and her family members.
2. It is pointed out that on the statement of present petitioner aforesaid FIR was registered. Since then the private respondents No.6 to 11 were extending threats. She gave representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala (Annexure P-3) but no action is taken.
3. Notice of motion.



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4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State. On instructions from SI Manjit Singh, he submits that respondents No.6 to 10 have been arrested in the aforesaid FIR on 15.07.2024 and only respondent No.11 is left.
5. Considering the aforesaid facts, it is clear that prompt action has been taken in FIR registered on the statement of petitioner. Respondents No. 3 to 5 are directed to consider representation dated 06.07.2024, Annexure P-3. In case petitioner apprehends any threat to her life and liberty, respondents No.3 to 5 are directed to take adequate measures considering the threat perception.
6. Petition is accordingly disposed of.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
