NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent No.2 to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner, who rendered 20 years of regular satisfactory service with respondent No.2 but no benefits i.e. leave encashment/gratuity/commute pension benefit and till date nothing is given to the petitioner and for quashing office order no.466/2024 dated 22.04.2024 passed by respondent No.2.
2. After arguing the case for some time and realising that in view of settled law, no relief at this stage can be granted until conclusion of the proceedings in criminal case pending against the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action after the conclusion of criminal trial.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
