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In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner has already retired from service and after her retirement, she was issued a charge sheet, which charge sheet could not have been issued to her by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the present writ petition was filed before the pensionary benefits of the petitioner had not been released and though, after filing of the present petition, all the



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pensionary benefits have been released to the petitioner but the petitioner has only been paid provisional pension, which has not been made regular.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a direction is issued to the respondents to conclude the enquiry proceedings pending against the petitioner in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer further prejudice.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case, enquiry proceedings have not been concluded so far, the same will be concluded within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of this order in case , the petitioner cooperates.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will extend all the cooperation needed in concluding the enquiry proceedings.

Keeping in view the undertaking given by the learned counsel for the respondent-State, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State to conclude the enquiry proceedings pending against the petitioner within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of this order and, thereafter, decide whatever benefits are yet to be released to the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Civil miscellaneous application pending, if any is also disposed of.
