1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 25.01.2019 passed in CWP-3552-2018.

2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Renu Sogan, Administrator, HSVP, Gurugram, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place. The costs of Rs.10,000/- as imposed upon respondents No.1 and 3 vide order dated 08.05.2024, have also been deposited, vide receipt dated 31.07.2024.

3. Counsel for respondents No.1 and 3 submits that the original amount, as well as, interest @ 9% per annum, interest @ 12% per annum, alongwith penal interest @ 12% per annum, has already been paid to the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.

5. Dismissed.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
