This appeal has been filed challenging order dated 01.07.2024 passed in CM No.9654 of 2024 in CWP No.7552 of 2024 to the extent that appellants are being permitted to join through outsourcing agency only. There is a further prayer for directing respondents to allow the appellants to continue in service in the same manner, in terms and conditions as prior to passing of relieving orders.

2. Learned counsel for appellants after arguing at length submits that only apprehension of appellants is that they may not be put to prejudice in the pending writ petition by joining service through Manpower Agency.
3. Learned counsel for respondents submits that such an apprehension is clearly illfounded as the matter would necessarily have to

be decided on merits thereof and not on the basis of subsequent event where the appellants may have joined through Manpower Agency, in view of the interim order.

- 4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the appellants seeks to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to the appellants to raise all available pleas before the learned Single Judge.
- 5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
