This appeal has been filed by the claimant by the prayer to enhance the compensation granted by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridkot.

On the last date of hearing, it was brought to our notice by the counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company that the appeal filed by the Insurance Company against the order passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridkot, qua the accident in question was partly allowed and compensation was decreased. On 20.08.2024, the registry was directed to attach the record of FAO-211-2007 with this appeal. We have perused the record of above said FAO-211-2007. The contention raised by counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company is correct. The above said appeal bearing FAO-211-2007 was disposed of by this High Court on 21.07.2009.

In view of above, it appears that the present appeal has become infructuous and it is disposed of accordingly. However, Mr. Paramjit Singh Brar, Advocate for the appellant states that the claimant is a illiterate lady. She had no information in so far as the disposed of FAO-211-2007 is concerned. If that is so, the appellant may avail appropriate remedy as per law.
