1. The prayer made in the present petition is for directing the official respondents to consider the case of petitioner for appointment as Anganwari Worker and quash the appointment of respondent No.4, since she has forged the signatures of Sarpanch and others while filling her application form.
2. Learned State counsel at the outset submits that, in view of the letter dated 24.1.2020, Annexure R-1, the services of respondent No.4 have been terminated.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions, prays that a liberty be granted to her to claim appointment by filing a representation, along with all requisite certificates, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.
4. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.
5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of

the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioner submits a representation within a period of 4 weeks, the same shall be decided by the respondents by taking into consideration the pleas raised and requisite documents, if produced, within a period of four months and if found entitled, necessary benefit be granted forthwith. However, in the eventuality of the relief being denied, a speaking order be passed, after associating her therewith.
