1. Instant revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for directing the Executing Court to execute the arbitration award dated 23.10.2019, Annexure P1, in a time bound manner.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that after the award, Annexure P1, was passed, petitioner filed an execution petition, Annexure P3 in the year 2019 and upon being served, the respondent filed objections as is evident from order dated 20.05.2022 (at page 93 of the paper-book) to the execution petition. Counsel submits that the proceedings are being repeatedly adjourned and in the meanwhile petition filed under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short "the Act") by the respondent was dismissed by learned Additional District Judge, SAS Nagar (Mohali) on 29.02.2024, Annexure P2 and the respondent has not preferred any appeal till date. Counsel asserts that as the petitioner has



been unable to get any benefit of the award, a direction may be issued to the Executing Court to conclude the proceedings within a specified time frame.

3. I have considered the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.

4. As objections filed by the respondent are pending before the Executing Court for the last more than two years and no appeal has been preferred under Section 37 of the Act, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Executing Court to decide the objections as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of communication of the copy of this order.
