The instant petition was filed for seeking issuance of writ in the nature of quo warranto/certiorari for directing respondents No.6 and 7 to vacate the office of the Chief Medical Officer and EMT on the allegations of corruption and embezzlement/misappropriation of public money.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the petitioners, in the present case have levelled various allegations against respondents No.6 and 7 qua working as Chief Medical Officer and EMT alleging that they have violated various instructions/directions issued by the Government in order to derive wrongful gains. It is, however, not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are espousing the above issues in larger public interests and do not have any individual or direct loss as a result of the same.

Counsel has been confronted about maintainability of the petition as a private cause especially when there is no personal legal loss or injury.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition so as to pursue his alternative/appropriate remedies as per law.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberty as aforesaid.
