The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to decide the execution petition i.e. EA-36-2021 filed by the petitioner on 24.08.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has filed Execution Petition No. EA-36-2021 (Annexure P-4) but no action has taken by the respondent No.1-District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Faridabad.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.1-District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Faridabad is directed to decide the Execution Petition No. EA-36-2021 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel for respondents No. 2, 3 and 4 does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.1-District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Faridabad to consider and decide the Execution Petition No. EA-36-2021 (Annexure P-4) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
