In response to our order dated 25.04.2024, learned counsel for respondent No.2 has shared with us a communication dated 25.04.2024, issued by the Chairman, Improvement Trust, Amritsar, vide which, it is conveyed that considering the decision dated 08.10.2010, rendered by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP-6565-2010, the exercise for granting exemption as regards land of the petitioner, which forms part of khasra number 1147, in terms of the lay out plan and the prevalent position, after obtaining necessary approvals under the rules, shall be carried out. And the necessary resolution in this regard shall be passed by the Trust within a period of one week from today. Whereafter, the papers shall be forwarded to the State Government for necessary approval/decision.

Likewise, learned State counsel submits that immediately on receipt of the said resolution, the same shall be taken cognizance of by the competent authority. And the necessary formalities shall be carried out within a further period of two weeks therefrom.

A copy of the said communication is retained on record as Mark X, and has also been shared with learned counsel for the petitioner.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of, in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the respondents.

In the wake of the position sketched out above and in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition is accordingly disposed of.

This Court is sanguine that the authorities shall look into the matter in the right earnest. And the necessary exercise, as indicated above, shall be carried out within the time indicated by learned counsel for the respondents.
