1. In this revision petition, the plaintiffs assail the correctness of the District Judge's order while refusing to transfer the case from one Presiding Judge to other.

2. Learned counsel representing the parties have been heard at length.

3. Learned senior counsel representing the petitioners has referred to various daily orders passed by the Court from time to time to support his version.

4. On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the respondents submits that they have no objection if the case is transferred to any



other Presiding Judge, subject to the condition that the case is heard on the next date of hearing i.e. 03.08.2024 because it is fixed for final arguments.

4. Learned senior counsel representing the petitioner submits that the plaintiffs will not seek any adjournment.
5. Without going into the correctness of the allegations made in the application, it is considered appropriate to transfer the case from the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram to the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gurugram.
6. It is expected that the Civil Judge (Senior Division) will make sincere endeavor for disposal of the suit on the next date of hearing.
7. The revision petition stands disposed of.
8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
