The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing/setting aside of complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 titled as 'India Bulls Housing Finance Ltd. Vs. Vipul Vishanji Soni' CIS No. NACT-1395-2018 dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P-6) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act have been withdrawn by the respondent.

The order passed by the learned Presiding Officer, National Lok Adalat-cum-Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram dated 09.03.2024, is produced in the Court which is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place in the file.

A perusal of the said order indicates that on request of learned counsel for the complainant/respondent, the case was taken up and in view of the statement, the complaints were dismissed as withdrawn.
