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In a claim petition filed by Renu W/o Rajesh Kumar seeking compensation, Shanti Devi, mother of the deceased was impleaded as proforma respondent No.4. Shanti Devi was not awarded any compensation whatsoever by the learned MACT.

Two appeals have been preferred against the award of the learned tribunal; one by the wife of the deceased being FAO No.2019 of 2012 and the other by Shanti Devi, mother of the deceased, who was proforma respondent in the claim petition and no compensation had been awarded to her. She has since died. Time was granted to bring on record the legal representatives of the deceased appellant. No application has been moved for bringing on record the legal representatives of Shanti Devi, till date.

However, from the record, it appears that Renu, daughter-in-law of Shanti Devi, since deceased, is the only LR, who is already appellant in FAO No.2019 of 2012 and especially having regard to the fact that no compensation has been granted by the learned tribunal to Shanti Devi, the appeal preferred by Renu is settled through a compromise, for & on behalf of all the claimants, if any.

In view of the compromise effected between the claimant and the Insurance Company in FAO No.2019 of 2012, this appeal has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
