1. Petitioner (Sucha Singh Dhillon) has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct respondents No.3 to 5 to conduct the demarcation of the land measuring 19 Kanals and 8 Marlas, situated in the area of Village Kairon-I, Hadbast No.255, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran bearing *Khata Khatoni* No.314/722 and *Killa* Nos.131//17/2/2(1-0), 18/2(3-16), 19/1/2/(2-2), 19/2/2(1-16), *kitta* 4, total area measuring 8 Kanals and 14 Marlas as per the *jamabandi* for the year 2016-17 in compliance with order dated 10.02.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Assistant Collector, Grade-II, Patti, District Tarn Taran.
