The prayer in the petition under Section 482 BNSS is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.176 dated 08.10.2022 under Sections 307, 160, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 323, 324, 506 IPC added later on) registered at P.S. Division No.2, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 22.07.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 22.07.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 22.07.2024 is made absolute.



However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
