1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner w.e.f. May, 2022 till date @ 14,200/- per month along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Pursuant to notice of motion, written statement on behalf of the respondents has been filed, wherein it has been stated as under :-

“xx xx xx xx xx

2. *That the petitioner through present civil writ petition is seeks for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to release the salary to him w.e.f. May, 2022 till date @ 14,200/- per month along with interest @ 18% per annum, whereas the petitioner is not entitled to get the same because petitioner never worked on muster roll after the year 1999. The petitioner had worked in the department on daily wages basis from September 1994 till the year 1999*



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with heavy break in service. During this period, the petitioner has not completed 240 days in any calendar year. After the year 1999, the petitioner never worked under the supervision of the department.”

3. In view of the averments made in the written statement, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail other legal remedy in accordance with law, if available.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
